



The-3-Gifts

The גְּמֶרָא teaches that the Jewish people were given three excellent leaders: מַּיָר (Moses), מֹשֶׁה (Aaron) and מְרָיָם (Miriam). Because of them, three excellent gifts were given to the Jewish people while they journeyed in the desert: The Well which provided water in the desert, the Pillar of Cloud which surrounded the Jewish people during their travels, flattening land and destroying harmful reptiles and the miraculous מָרָיָם (manna) food which provided nourishment. The Well was given in the merit of מָשֶׁה and the אַהָּרֹן in the merit of מִשֶּׁה and the אַהַּרֹן

When מִּטְה died, the Well disappeared but returned in the merits of מִּטְה and מֹשֶׁה. When מֹשֶׁה died, the Pillar of Cloud went away but came back in מֹשֶׁה 's merit. But when מֹשֶׁה passed away, all three gifts disappeared forever.


How did מֹשֶׁה merit to have all three gifts? The גְּמָרָא explains that since he prayed for many people, he is considered to have the merit of many people!
