are entitled to special portions of food from the Jewish community called, "תְּרוּמָה". The פֹהֵן's family may eat תְּרוּמָה, too, including his wife. This is true even if his wife is not a בֿהֵן.


A פֿהֵן is not allowed to marry a divorced woman or a woman who has performed פֿהֵן גָּדוֹל also may not marry a widow.

What if a פֿהֵן went ahead and married a divorced woman or one who performed חֵלִיצֵה? May she eat תּרוּמָה as his wife?

The answer is no. By marrying a forbidden woman, the מַהֵן makes her a הֲלָלָה ("profaned woman"). A הְּלָלָה may not eat הְּרוֹמָה.

But what if she was the daughter of a פֿהֵן and was already eating מְרוּמָה as part of her father's family before she was married?

says as soon as the first part of marriage is done, when the groom gives her a ring for marriage, she may not eat תְּרוּמָה since she is a רַבִּי שִׁמְעוֹן and רַבִּי שִׁמְעוֹן say she would still be able to eat the תְּרוּמָה of her father since she is not fully married to the כֹּהֵן.
