Inside The Daf

WORD OF THE DAY:

אֶהְדִּי

"EACH OTHER"

There's a lot to be done every day in the בית המקדש (Holy Temple). There are many Torah commandments to bring different types of offerings. Fortunately, אבוי listed the order of the daily service in the בית המקדש:

2. מערכה שנייה של קטורת - Second Arrangement for Incense

The smaller arrangement of wood used make kindling for the קטורת (incense)

10. מנחה - Flour Offering of the Daily Offering

Flour mixed with oil is placed on the Altar with the קרבן תמיד

1. מערכה גדולה - Large Arrangement

The large arrangement of wood in the middle of the מזבח (Altar)

9. אברים - The Daily Offering's Limbs

Burning the limbs of the תמיד on the מזבח

6. דם התמיד - Blood of the Daily Offering

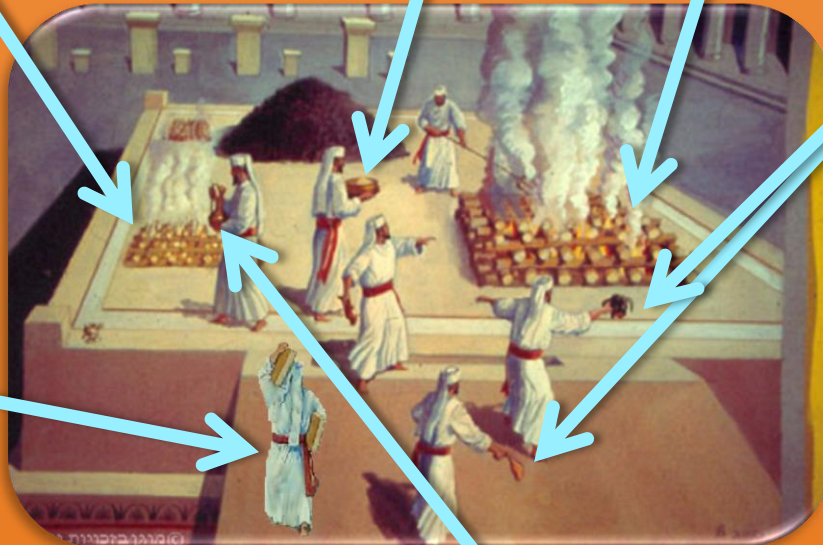
Collecting the blood of the קרבן תמיד (Daily offering) in a vessel, bringing it to the מזבח and throwing it there

5. הטבת חמש נרות - Improving Five Candles

Cleaning out the charred wicks and oil leftover in **five** of the מנורה's lamps, and replacing them with fresh wicks and oil

3. סידור שני גזירי עצים - Placing Two Blocks of Wood

Placing two blocks of wood on top of the wood arrangement to increase the flames



7. הטבת שתי נרות - Improving Two Candles

Cleaning out the charred wicks and oil leftover in **two** of the מנורה's lamps, and replacing them with fresh wicks and oil



12. נסבין - Daily Offering Libations

Wine poured on the מזבח with the קרבן תמיד

13. מוספין - Extra Offerings

On לבונה, (beginning of the month) ראש חודש and מועדים (Festivals), extra animals are offered as קרבנות (Offerings)

11. חביתין - Bread Loaf Offering

כהן גדול burns six of loaves of bread on the מזבח



4. דישון מזבח הפנימי - Cleaning the Inner Altar
the removal of ashes from the Golden מזבח where the קטורת is burned

8. קטורת - Incense

Burning the incense mixture on the Golden מזבח

14. בזיבין - Spoons
Two spoons of לבונה (frankincense) are placed together with the לחם הפנים (Showbreads)

15. תמיד של בין הערבים - Afternoon Daily Offering

A קרבן תמיד is brought every afternoon

Inside the Sanctuary

The **גמרא** teaches the positioning of the different vessels in the **היכל** (Sanctuary) of the **בית המקדש**.

When a **כהן** enters the **היכל** he comes to the Golden Altar of the **קטורת** first. To his right is the **שֶׁלֶחַן** (Table) with the Showbreads. This is on the north side of the Sanctuary.

On the **כהן**'s left side, the south side of the **היכל**, was the **מנורה**. This means the **מנורה** was facing the **שֶׁלֶחַן**, keeping with the **פסוק** (verse) that says, "**וְאֵת הַמְּנֹרָה נֹכַח הַשֶּׁלֶחַן**", "and the **מנורה** facing the Table" (**לה**, שמות כו, Exodus 26:35.)

The Golden Altar was right in the middle of the Sanctuary, but it was drawn out a little to the east in the direction where the **כהן** would enter.

Did You Know...

ריש לקיש says we should not pass over an opportunity to do a **מצוה** (commandment). From this we learn that we should place the box with **תפלין** (phylacteries) that goes on the arm closer to our reach than the box of **תפלין** that goes on the head. That way we don't reach over the head **תפלין** to get to the arm **תפלין**.
