There is a מְצְוָה (commandment) for every adult male to give half a coin to the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָשׁ every year. These coins were used to buy community קָּרְבָּנוֹת (sacrifices) such as the daily תָּמִיד offerings.

The גְּמָרָא brings a case where an entire town sent its half אֶמֶרָא coins with a courier to the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ but they were stolen or lost on the way. Do the townspeople have to give another half שֵׁקֵל Is the courier responsible to pay?

If half שָׁקֵל coins from other Jews had already come into the Temple had already been sorte into baskets in the treasury, the stolen or lost coins are considered to be part of the coins that were already in the Temple. This means, the courier would swear to the Temple treasurers that he didn't handle the coins irresponsibly, and he wouldn't have to pay for them.

But if the Temple officials had not yet sorted into baskets the other half טֶּקֶל coins, the stolen or lost coins are considered to still belong to the townspeople who gave them, not the Temple. The courier

therefore swears to the townspeople that he didn't handle the coins irresponsibly, and he wouldn't have to pay for them. Each townsperson, however, would still owe another half שֶׁקֶל to the Temple as part of their מִצְנָה.

A מדות Moment

"Did you hear?" asked Mrs. Lifschitz, "Mrs. Gottleib is in the hospital!"

"Oy, poor woman!" said Mrs. Koenig. "And with a family as big as hers, it must be so difficult now to feed them regular meals."

"I would love to cook to help her out," sympathized Mrs. Lifschitz, "but I couldn't possibly afford to cook a meal for 15 people!"

"If I may say something, Mrs. Lifschitz," said Mrs. Koenig, "Don't think that you can't perform this מַצְוָה (commandment) because you are not rich enough. Hashem wants everyone to have a part in His מַצְוֹת (commandments) no matter how poor or rich they may be. That's why every man, no matter how rich or poor, had to participate in the מצוה of giving a half שׁקל. The half שׁקל went

to buy community sacrifices and it is important that every Jew have a share in that."

"I suppose you're right," said Mrs. Lifschitz. "I may not be able to cook an *entire* meal for such a large family, but at least I can make a soup or something."

"And I can call some other people to prepare other foods for the Gottleib family," said Mrs. Koenig. "That way, their meals will be taken care of, but no one person will have to spend more than they can afford preparing food for them."

"That's a great idea," said Mrs. Lifschitz. "It's good to know that whatever the מָצְוַה, you can always participate!"

The Missing Goat

Have you ever lost anything really important? Did you end up finding it afterwards?

Imagine if the "לַשָּׁם" goat (which was slaughtered as an offering) got lost. Then another goat was

taken in its place and slaughtered as the "לַשֶּׁם" offering. Then guess what happened? The lost "לַשֵּׁם" goat was found! The question is: what do we do with this goat?

רבי יהודה says, the first goat should be left to die. This is because the first goat was meant to be a קַרְבָּן חַטָּאת (sin offering) and if an owner of a sin offering loses that animal and

uses another animal as his קרבן חַטָאת, the rule is that the first sin offering is left to die.

רבי אָלְעַזַר and רָבִּי שִׁמְעוֹן say the "found" goat should be sent to graze in a field until it develops a blemish. Once an animal develops a blemish, it is not be allowed to be used as a קרבו (sacrifice). The goat should then be sold by the בֵּית הַמְקְדֵשׁ (Holy Temple) officials, and the money they get should be used to buy other קרבנות.

If someone sets aside his yearly half שֶׁקֶל to give to the Temple and it gets stolen or lost, then gives another half שֶׁקֶול to the Temple, then finds the *first* half שֶׁקֶל and gives it to the Temple, according to תַּנָא קַמָּא he must still give another half שָׁקֶול the following year. According to רַבִּי יְהוּדָה, he wouldn't have to give another half שֶׁקֶל the next year.
