## Inside the Daf

We have learned (pg. 43) that a **מְעֵשָׂה אוֹמֵן** (professional job) is usually not allowed on **חול המועד**. One type of **מְעֵשָׂה אוֹמֵן** is calligraphy. Many official documents use calligraphy in their creation. Sometimes, one may suffer a loss if these documents are not written on **חול המועד**. The **משנה** teaches that in such a case, these documents may be written.

For example, one may write **קדושי נשים**, or, marriage documents on **חול המועד**. **קדושי נשים** are documents that say, "You are married to me." If a man gives such a document to a woman, the couple enter into the first stage of marriage.

**קדושי נשים** may be written on **חול המועד** because if they are not, the groom may suffer a loss. After all, if he is not quick to marry his bride, another man may come along and marry her first!

Some say that **קדושי נשים** are not actual marriage documents, but documents that record the amount of money the parents of the bride and groom promise their children after marriage.

"How much money will you give to the new couple?" the father of the bride asks the father of the groom.

"Such-and-such amount," the father of the groom says. Then he asks the father of the bride the same question. These amounts are then written in documents called **קדושי נשים** and may even be written on **חול המועד**.

## Did You Know...

Even though one may not do laundry on חול המועד, if one has only one shirt to wear, he or she may wash it.



A mourner is not allowed to cut his hair while he is mourning the loss of a close relative. But what about cutting nails?

רב ענן, the son of תחליפא says (in the name of שמואל) that a mourner may cut his or her fingernails and toenails. רב חניא בר אשי adds (in the name of רב) that a mourner may not use scissors for this task, but must use one's own nails or teeth.

Once, when a close relative of פנחס, the brother of מר שמואל, died, שמואל went to visit him and saw that his nails were not cut.

"Why have you not cut your nails?" שמואל asked.

"If you were mourning, would you have taken your mourning so lightly and cut *your* nails?" פנחס replied.

Sure enough, a close relative of שמואל soon passed away.


