



Inside the Daf


We know that if a man does without children, his brother is commanded to marry (perform "יְבוּם") the dead man's wife. We also know that there are times when the brother cannot perform יְבוּם with the wife, for example, if the wife is his daughter.

What if the dead man's wife was a אַיְלוּנִית? Would the living brother have to perform יָבוּם with her?

The word "אַיְלוֹנִית" comes from the word, "אָנָל"," or, "male ram." An אַיְלוֹנִית is an adult woman who has grown up to be a full woman and who has strong male features (for example, an unusually deep voice). We assume an אַיְלוֹנִית is unable to have children. Would one have to perform יָבוֹם with such a woman?

יבו points out that one may not perform יבום with such a woman since the purpose of performing יברים is so the wife may "give birth" to a child (see דברים Deut. 25,6), and an אֵיְלוּנְית is unable to have children.

Not only does one not perform יְבוּם with an אַיְלוּגִית, but even if the אַיְלוּגִית had a co-wife (that is, the dead man had two wives, an אַיְלוּגִית and a non-אַיְלוֹגִית), the non-אַיְלוֹגִית co-wife would also not perform יָבוּם with the living brother.





Refusal

If a married couple want to end their marriage, the husband gives the wife a divorce document called a "נָּט" and their marriage is over.

But if a girl's mother or older brother allowed her to get married before the age of twelve, the Sages made it easier for her to end the marriage. The girl may perform "מָאוּנְן", or "refusal." This means that, in front of two witnesses, the girl simply says that she does not wish to live with her husband, and their marriage is over with.

The girl may not only perform "מָאוּן" on her husband, but if he dies and she does not want to perform מָאוּן with her husband's brother, she may "refuse" him with מָּאוֹן, also.


says, if the dead husband had two wives, one being the girl under twelve years old and the other an adult, the living brother may not even perform יבוֹם with the adult wife once the other wife has "refused" him.
