




## Inside\_the\_Daf

The גְּמֶרֶא gives an example of someone who can be performing four sins by eating just one piece of meat. For each of the sins he would have to bring a חַטָּאת (sin) offering to atone for his wrongdoing. See the diagram below to learn which sins he would be violating by eating the meat.

He would also have to bring an אָשָׁם (guilt) offering for benefitting from an animal that was meant to be offered as a sacrifice.




# Accidentally Eating

One of the special privileges of פֿהָנִים is that they receive gifts from the Jewish people. One of these gifts is called "תְּרוֹמָה," a part of each crop that is given to בֿהָנִים.

A מָהֵן and his family may eat תְּרוּמָה. But if a פֿהֵן is the son divorced woman or of a woman who performed a חֲלִיצָה ceremony (removing of a shoe), he is not allowed to eat תָּרוּמָה.

What happens if he eats רַבִּי אֱלִיעֶזֶר says he must pay back the value of the כֹהֵן to the כֹהֵן. He also must pay the מֹהֵן an extra fifth of whatever the value was of the תּרוּמָה that he ate.

ברי יְהוֹשֵׁעַ says that he does not have to pay anything back. Since he thought the was performing the מִצְוָה (commandment) of eating holy food, he does not have to be punished.



#### A-הודף Moment

Chana's older sister was in bed with the flu. Chana thought it would be a nice idea to bring her a hot bowl of chicken soup. When she brought it to her, she accidentally spilled it over her sister.

"How could you do that!" exclaimed her sister.

"It was an accident! I was trying to bring you chicken soup for your flu. I didn't mean to spill it!"

"I don't care what you *meant* to do!"

"You should care," said their father who was standing in the doorway. "מַצְוָה says if you sin while trying to perform a מָצְוָה, you are not punished. Your sister was only trying to give you something good to eat while you were sick. You shouldn't be upset with her if she accidentally spilled it on you."



### Did You Know...

בְּיִּיְהוֹשֵׁעֵ says if someone sins by trying to do a מִצְוָה, he is not punished. For example, if someone circumsizes a baby on the Sabbath, even though he should have been circumsized on the following day, he would not be punished for this.
