Inside the Daf

A woman is allowed to marry only one man. If she marries two men, the משנה teaches that she will lose certain privileges. See the infographic below to see what happens if a woman marries two men.

A Woman Who Marries Two Husbands...

Must Leave. The woman must leave both husbands



Must Receive a Divorce Document. The woman must receive a גט (divorce document) from both husbands



May Not Eat תרומה. If she is the daughter of a כהן, she may not return to her father's home to eat תרומה.



Keeps her Vows. A husband may annul a wife's vows. Neither husband may annul her vows.



Receives no כתובה. The woman does not receive any money from either husband



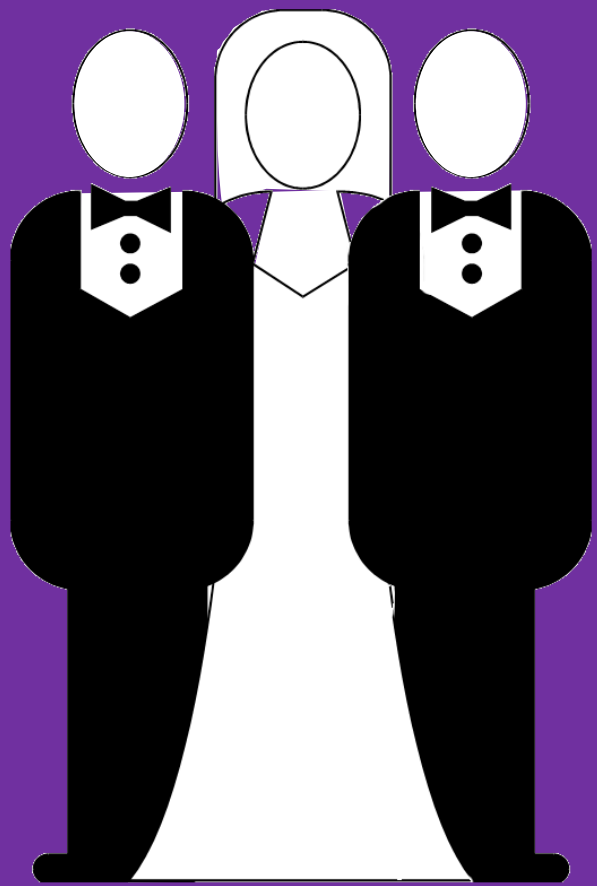
May Never Marry a כהן. A כהן may not marry her since he may not marry a divorced woman



Children are ממזרים. The children the woman has from either husband are ממזרים (illegitimate) and may not marry into the Jewish community



May Not Contaminate a כהן. If either husband is a כהן he may not come into contact with her dead body, even though a כהן may come into contact with the dead body of his wife



Coming Back Home

What a privilege to be a בִּתּוּלָה! In addition to other benefits, a בִּתּוּלָה and his family may eat the תְּרוּמָה tithe which must be separated from the other Jews' crops.



may once again eat תְּרוּמָה. The Torah tells us this in a פְּסוּקָה (verse) that if she is widowed or divorced, "She will return to her father's house as in her youth [and] she may eat of her father's bread [that is, תְּרוּמָה]."

Of course, while a בִּתּוּלָה's daughter lives at home, she too may partake of תְּרוּמָה. Once she marries a non-בִּתּוּלָה, she may no longer eat תְּרוּמָה.

If the בִּתּוּלָה's daughter has a child from her non-בִּתּוּלָה husband, she may not return to her father's house to eat תְּרוּמָה.

But what happens if the בִּתּוּלָה's daughter is widowed or divorced from the non-בִּתּוּלָה husband? In that case, she returns to her father's home and

Usually, a בֵּית דִּין (Jewish court) only accepts the testimony of two witnesses. But a court will accept the testimony of even one witness to say that a man is dead and that his wife may remarry.
