When the בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל (Children of Israel) were in the desert, a special ceremony took place for the first seven days that the אֲבוֹדָה (Service) was performed in the מִשְׁכָּן (Tabernacle). These days were called the "שִׁבְעַת יְמֵי הַמְּלוּאִים" ("Seven Days of Filling.")

During this time, many קּרְבָּנוֹת (sacrifices) were offered and the מִשְׁכָּן who would serve in the מִשְׁכָּן were anointed with oil.

According to רַבִּי יוֹחָגַן, if the following things were not done during מְלוּאִים, the מְּרָבָּן (sacrifice) being offered was not accepted:

A-חודף-Moment

"Yaakov! Wake up and get dressed, it's time to daven!"

"But I am dressed...kind of," Yaakov said to his father.

"Yaakov," his father laughed, "you are wearing your pajamas! You shouldn't *daven* in your pajamas."

"Why not?" his son asked.

"Yaakov, we learn that the בְּהָנִים wore special clothes when they performed the עֲבוֹדָה (service) in the מִשְׁכָּן. Did you ever wonder why they needed special clothes? Well, one reason was out of respect to their holy job, and to the מִשְׁכָּן itself. We learn from them that we also have to dress respectfully when we perform *our* special עַבוֹדָה – praying to Hashem."

"Wow," Yaakov said, "I see what you mean. I have to show respect to Hashem by dressing properly. Could you please leave my room now?"

"Why, Yaakov?"

"I've got to get dressed!"

- אַמִיכָה Leaning

The animal's owner has to lean with all his might on the head of his sacrifice.





אבויפה – Waving

The chest and the right hind leg of a קַּרְבָּן שְׁלָמִים are held by their owner, while the בּהֵן places his hands underneath. They are then waved in four directions and presented as a gift to a בּהֵן.



פְּרִישֵּׁת שִׁבְעָה – Separating for Seven Days

The אַהֲרֹן) פֿהֵן גָּדוֹל) had to separate himself for the seven days of the מִּלוּאִים. He would serve on the eighth day.



רְבּוּי בְּגָדִים – Extra Clothing

Every פֿתֵן has four special pieces of clothing to wear while performing the עבוֹדָה.

The פֿתַן גָּדוֹל wears four extra clothes.

Dressing-Up

There is a dispute between רֵבְּי יוֹחָגֶן and רֵבְּי יוֹחָגָן regarding the order in which מֹשֶׁה dressed מֹשֶׁה and his sons. According to one opinion מֹשֶׁה dressed אַהְרֹן and then his sons. According to the second opinion מֹשֶׁה dressed them

all at the same time.

The גְּמָרָא asks about the future, in the times of מָשִׁיח, how will מֹשֶׁה dress אֲהָרן and his sons then? The גְּמָרָא answers that in the future we will be able to ask מֹשֶׁה, and his sons how to properly don the Priestly garments because they will come back to life.

Did You Know.

The belief that the dead will come back to life (הְמָתִים קְּחָיַּיִים) is one of the **most**important beliefs of the Jewish faith!
