Our גְּמָרָא describes the גָּמָרָא (Courtyard) of the בֵּית הַמְּקָדָשׁ



שַׁעַר הַבְּכוֹרוֹת The Gate of the Firstborns

First-born kosher animals are brought through here to be sacrificed.



This gate is opened once a year on the holiday of סוכות for carrying the water for the נסוך המים (Water Libation).

לְשָׁכַּת בֵּית אַבְטִינִס **Chamber of the Avtinas Family**

The room where the קטרת (incense) was prepared and stored.



This is where the intestines of the קרבנות were rinsed out.

לשָׁכַּת הַפַּרְוָה **Parvah** Chamber

The כֹּהַנִים salt the hides of burnt offerings in this room. They may keep these hides.

Salt Chamber

This room stored the salt for קרבנות (sacrifices)

לשכת עושי חביתין The Chamber of Those who Prepare the **Chavitin Offering**

This offering of twelve loaves of bread was burned by the מובח on the מובח in the morning and afternoon.



שער הדלקה The Gate of Kindling

Wood for the מובח (Altar) is brought through here.



שער הניצוץ The Gate of the Spark

Where coals are kept burning to rekindle fires that have gone out.

Did You Know..

Once there was a צְדוֹקִי (Sadducee) פהן גָּדוֹל. He boasted about having performed the service of the קָטֹרֶת incorrectly. A few days later, he was found dead in a trash-heap with worms coming out of his nose!

שַׁעַר הַקָּרָבָּן

The Gate of the Sacrifice Through this gate the holiest

offerings (קַדְשֵׁי קָדָשִׁים) entered the Courtyard.



לשבת הגולה **Chamber of the Diaspora**

This chamber contains a well that filled with fresh water every day. It was named for those who dug the well when

they arrived from the Golah (Diaspora).



לִשְׁכַּת פַּרְהֶדְרִין Parhedrin Chamber

This room is set aside for the 's daily use. It is also where he lived for the seven days before יום כפור. a.k.a.


The Wood) לִשְׁכַּת הַעֵּץ Chamber) since it was made from wood (ראב"ד)

לִשָּׁכַּת הַגַּזִית The Chamber of Hewn Stone

Where the Great Sanhedrin sat in judgement.

לִשְׁכַּת פִּנְחָס הַמִּלַבֵּישׁ The Room of Pinchas the Dresser

This room stored the בגדי כהונה (Kohen clothing). Named for he who first distributed and collected the בֹהֵנים's clothing.

Nikanor Gate

The eastern gate of the עזרה (Courtyard) is named for he who commissioned the brass doors which closed upon -Awake



Have you ever felt sleepy at a time when you needed to be awake? Did you do any tricks to stay awake?

The כהן גדול would not sleep the night of יום כפור. If he fell asleep, young בֹהֵנִים would flick their index fingers on the palm of his hand, making a loud sound and keeping him awake.

The פֿהֵן גָדוֹל would also walk on the cold floor to wake himself up and perform a difficult type of bow called "קידה." The strain surely kept him awake!
