

# DAF YOMA KIDS

## Inside\_The\_Daf

We learned that it is a good sign if the פֿתֵן גָּדוֹל selects the lottery that says "לַשֵּׁם" (for Hashem) with his right hand and not his left.

If the לַּשֵּׁם" picked up the lottery "לַשָּׁם" in his left hand the goat on the left would be offered as קרבּן חַטָּאת (sin offering).

לְהֵי עֲקִיבָּא students asked him if the כֹּחֵן גָּדוֹל would be allowed to switch the lottery to his right hand, along with the goat on the left.

רְבִּי עֲקִיבָא answered, "No. Don't give the צְדּוּקִים (Sadducees) a way to be overbearing."



רבי explains that רבי עקיבא meant to say, if we allow the כהן גדול to change the lottery process, the צדוקים will say we allow changes to be made in the Torah when the rules don't work out the way we like. They will say we do as we please without really listening to the Torah. To prevent this claim, רָבִּי עקיבא insisted the lottery stay in whichever hand it was chosen.

### Did You Know...

There are opinions in the גְּמֶרָא who hold that if the lottery for the two goats wasn't done, the בַּהֵן גָּדוֹל could himself choose which goat will be offered "לַשָּׁכִי" (to Hashem) and which one will be "לַצְוָאוֹל" (for לַצְוֹאוֹל")!

WORD OF THE DAY:

Who were the (אָדוֹקִים or אְדּוּקִים) (Sadducees)?

The צְדוֹקִים were students of צְדוֹק, and rejected תּוֹרָה (Oral Torah). In the time of the Second בֵּית they tried to change many practices in the Temple.



We have learned that of the two goats in the lottery, the one chosen "לַשֵּׁם" would be slaughtered for a מְרְבָּן חַשָּאת (sin offering.) What about the one chosen "לַעֵּיאוֹל"

The Torah tells us that the goat "לְעֵנְאוֵל" had a special purpose: it would **atone** for the sins of the Jewish people.

קבי יְהוּדָה says that the **atonement** happens when the blood of the לַשֵּׁם goat is sprinkled, after it is slaughtered as a sin offering.

בְּבִי שִּׁמְעוֹן says the **atonement** happens when the בּהֵן says says יְבִּי שִׁמְעוֹן (confession of sins) on the goat לַעַוַאוֵל.

Ronny Sussman had a problem. His math teacher suspected him of cheating on his last test. Ronny hadn't, but when he went to sharpen his pencil, Mrs. Hayworth thought he took a peek at his friend's test.
